He also works as a visiting Professor for Classical Indian Theatre at the Academy of Theatre Arts at the University of Mumbai. He has presented research papers at various national and international conferences and seminars and has publications in reputed peer-reviewed journals. He has successfully organized workshops and seminars at the state and national levels. He has been honoured by Govt of Maharashtra as 'Best Writer' for the Sanskrit one Act play 'Devasuni' in 2018.
