8. The objectives of the Program/activity/event	The international multidisciplinary seminar on "Dialogue and Silence in Philosophy" aims to explore the various dimensions of silence and dialogue. From Buddha's silence on "metaphysical" questions and Wittgenstein's injunction to pass over in silence that which cannot be said, to the Socratic silence in the dialogue Cleitophon, and the Kierkegaardian silence as divinity's communion with the individual, there are various nuances of "silence," some of which necessitate "dialogue."
9. Description of the Program/activity/event	The programme commenced on 18 <sup>th</sup> January, at 10.30 a.m. in the seminar hall, faculty Block B, with a welcoming address by Prof. Koshy Tharakan, Dean of the School of Sanskrit, Philosophy, and Indic Studies, followed by presentations from the participants. Six sessions of the seminar comprised sixteen participants, including research scholars, professors, and a

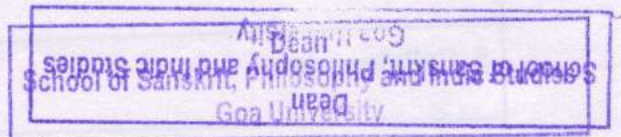

The seminar concluded on the 19th of January, with a vote of thanks from Dr Walter Menezes, Programme Director of SSPIS, followed by a discussion about the theme. The event attracted approximately 35-40 students and lecturers from Goa University, allied colleges, and the general public.
<b>10. The outcome of the event</b>	By exploring the relationship between silence and dialogue as it is embodied in diverse philosophical traditions and texts, the seminar unleashed the potential of dialogue in addressing both silence and the moments at which dialogue slips into silence.
