Admissions for M.Sc. Economics (Integrated) Programme 2024-25

Applications are invited for admission to the MSc. Economics (Integrated) Programme (5 year) offered at the Goa Business School, Goa University for the academic year 2024-25 through the online mode only. Interested candidates are informed to visit the Goa University website www.unigoa.ac.in for details.

Eligibility Criteria:

To be eligible for admission to the Programme leading to the of Degree M.Sc. Economics (Integrated): a candidate must have completed H.S.S.C. (10+2) examination or equivalent.

Selection Criteria:

An Entrance test shall be conducted for admission to M.Sc. Economics (Integrated) Programme.

100% weightage for the Entrance test scores.

Selected candidates whose HSSC results are awaited shall be granted Provisional Admission. Their admission shall be confirmed after the results are declared based on the eligibility. In case a candidate fails to clear the HSSC Examination, the admission shall stand canceled and the fees shall be refunded.

How to Apply:

Candidates need to fill the application form with all required details and upload required documents online on Goa University's dedicated GUMS Portal. There is a non-refundable application fee of Rs. 1000/- (INR One Thousand Only) for Unreserved, OBC, EWS Category candidates, Rs. 500/- (INR Five Hundred Only) for SC/ST Category candidates of Goa*. Persons with Disability are exempted from the payment of the application fees. Incomplete applications will not be considered for selection.

*Candidates applying for admission under these categories shall be required to submit a certificate to that effect issued by the officer of the rank of the Deputy Collector or above.

The fee for the program is INR 31,410/- for the first year.

- a) The **LAST DATE** for applying online is 5th June 2024.
- b) Candidates are advised in their own interest to apply online much before the closing date and not wait till the last date for applying/payment of application fee to avoid the possibility of disconnection/inability/ failure to log on to the website on account of heavy load on the website.
- c) Goa University does not assume any responsibility to candidates in case they are unable to submit their application by the last date on account of the aforesaid reasons or for any other reason beyond the control of the Goa University.
- d) Printout of the application form is **NOT REQUIRED** to be sent to the University.

Entrance Test:

Candidates are requested to note the following details regarding the Entrance Test.

- 1. No changes shall be entertained after the application is submitted online.
- 2. The Entrance Test shall be of One Paper of 100 marks, containing 50 objective Multiple-Choice Questions (MCQ) of 2 marks each. There shall be negative marking, where half a mark shall be deducted for each wrong answer. The duration of the GU-ART shall be 90 minutes.
- 3. The breakup of 100 marks for the Entrance Test Question Paper shall be as follows:
 - a. Section I (Least difficult) 15 Questions
 - b. Section II (Difficult) 15 Questions
 - c. Section III (Most difficult) 20 Questions
- 4. In case candidates who have answered the Entrance Test and have secured equal marks in the Ranking Test:
 - a. Section III scores shall be the first level of tie breaker, followed by Section II
 - b. In case the tie still exists, the University shall decide the order of merit.
- 5. The Entrance Test syllabus and Paper Pattern is given in **ANNEXURE I** which shall be conducted for admission to MSc. Economics (Integrated) Programme.

Admission Process:

- 1. The results of GU-ART Round shall be displayed on the University Website tentatively by **14**th **June 2024.**
- 2. Reserved Category Seats remaining vacant after the 1st Provisional List of the First Round of Entrance Test shall be transferred to the Un-reserved Category.
- 3. The Admission for the academic year 2024-25 shall be based on the following Ordinances:

TOPIC-WISE BREAK-UP OF MARKS

The entrance exam paper consisting of 100 marks (50 questions) shall be split into the following components.

- 10 marks (5 questions) Current Affairs (Post 2020)
- 30 marks (15 questions) English (Grammar and Language)
- 30 marks (15 questions) Logical Reasoning
- 30 marks (15 questions) Mathematics

SECTION-WISE BREAK-UP OF MARKS

The entrance exam paper consisting of 100 marks (50 questions) shall be split into the following sections.

- Section I (Least difficult) 15 Questions
 - o 5 questions of Current Affairs
 - o 10 questions of English
- Section II (Difficult) 15 Questions
 - o 5 questions of English
 - o 10 questions of Logical Reasoning
- Section III (Most difficult) 20 Questions
 - o 5 questions of Logical Reasoning
 - o 15 questions of Mathematics
