Report on One-Day National Seminar on the theme
Rights of Elderly Citizens: Issues and Challenges**

ManoharParrikar School of Law, Governance and Public Policy in collaboration with D.D. Kosambi School of Social Sciences and Behavioural Studies, Goa University supported by the Directorate of Social Welfare, Government of Goa organized a One-Day National Seminar titled *The Rights of Elderly Citizens: Issues and Challenges* on 27th March 2024 in the Auditorium of Block E, Chemistry, Science Block, Goa University from 9.00 am onwards. The Seminar aimed at shedding light on the myriad struggles faced by senior citizens and to awaken society's consciousness on the obligations they have towards safeguarding the same. In the welcome address, the Dean of MPS, Professor Rajendra S. Gad spoke about the pressing need to address the various challenges faced by the elderly people. The Chief Guest for the inaugural function, IPS Officer Jaspal Singh, DGP said that the Police Department gives special care and attention in addressing the cases brought to them by Senior Citizens. Beat Officers are aware of all the infrastructural facilities and also about the number of senior citizens in their locality and they also get themselves registered through the Beat Officers. The Dean of DDKSSBS, Professor Ganesh Somayaji emphasized that the issues faced by the elderly is no more a simple, personal and moral one but it has become public. Shri Ajit Panchwadkar, Director of Social Welfare stressed the need to protect the rights of the elderly in an ideal society. Today's young generation need to regain the ethics and values that they owe to the elderly. Shri Utpal Parrikar, Industrialist




emphasized the pivotal role played by Rule of Law in enhancing the status of the country. Dr. Vijay M. Gawas, Assistant Professor, MPSLGPP proposed the vote of Thanks.

The first technical session was titled '*The Rights of the Elderly*' and was chaired by Dr. Kim Couto, Associate Professor, VMSalgaocar College of Law. Dr. Sandhya Ram, Associate Professor, VM Salgaocar College of Law depicted the population pyramid for the years 2000-2050 with old age dependency ratio. She highlighted the old age dignity factor which included compromises and prejudices such as self-pity, neglect, burden, dependency, abuse and elucidated it comprehensively. Shri JatinRamaiya, Advocate of High Court of Bombay at Goa spoke on the Maintenance Tribunal. He elaborated on Article 21, the pending cases of Senior Citizens and the role of the Courts and lawyers in addressing the issues of the elderly.

Dr. Vishwanath M, Professor, Department of Law, Karnataka State Law University enunciated the Role of the Police for the protection of Senior Citizens. He emphasized on the collaboration between NGOs, locals and neighbourhood community for addressing the issues related to senior citizens . Dr. V. Sudesh, University of Law College Bangalore University deliberated on the factors that contribute to the vulnerability of senior citizens such as isolation, cognitive decline and dependency on caregivers. He elucidated the different forms of crimes against the elderly and the innovative approaches for addressing and preventing such crimes.

The second technical session was titled '*Role of State, Education Institutions and Health Departments*' and was chaired by Dr. Joanna Coelho, Associate Professor DDKSSSBS. Dr. Praful B. Chavate, Professor, Navjeevan Law College, Nashik enunciated the common perpetrators of mental harassment against the elderly. She elucidated the barriers that prevent elderly victims from reporting such as fear of retaliation, harassment, etc. The proactive measures to prevent these include respect, social inclusion, etc. Dr. Chavate highlighted relevant laws, regulations and ethical guidelines aimed at protecting the rights of well-being of citizens. Mr. SapreshDevidas, Asst. Professor, Kare College of Law deliberated on elderly citizens and physical exploitation. The common signs and symptoms of physical exploitation include frailty, disability, etc. He spoke about supportive services and interventional strategies. Dr. VivekYashwantDhupdale, Professor, Department of Law, Shivaji University, Kolhapur explained the assessment and treatment of age-related disabilities. He elaborated on age related disabilities and methods available to evaluate the same such as medical examinations, diagnostic tests, cognitive screenings and so on. He also spoke about Rehabilitation Services, Assistive Devices and Environmental Modifications. DrKotagiriSrinivas Rao, Associate Professor, VM



Salgaocar College of Law elucidated the importance of education and lifelong learning in fostering social connections, reducing isolation, enhancing memory, physical health and healthy lifestyle, personal empowerment and policy implications.

The third technical session titled '*Protection of the Elderly Citizens*' was chaired by Dr. Rahul Tripathi, Professor DDKSSBS. Dr. SathishGowda N, Professor of Law, Bangalore University talked about the five basic human rights of elderly persons which include the right to be treated with dignity in all aspects of life. He elaborated on the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Citizens Act, 2007. The elderly have access to justice through mechanisms such as legal aid programmes. Dr. ShrutiNadkarni, Assistant Professor, Kare College of Law elaborated on the welfare dimension such as establishment of old age homes, provision for medical care of seniors, protection of life and property of senior citizens, Sanjivani, issue of identity cards to senior citizens and so on. Smt. VijayaAmbre, Secretary Goa State Legal Authority, Bombay High Court at Goa explained the establishment of specialized legal aid programmes tailored to the needs of elderly citizens. Priority ought to be given to scheduling and streamlining cases related to the elderly. Dr. JyotiBhakare, Professor, Law Department, SavitribaiPhule, Pune University said that according to the UNFPA, India's elderly population will double by 2050 surpassing the number of children. She spoke on the social determinants of health and older adults. She enunciated the Madrid Plan 2002 and the global outlook adopted by the United Nations Organization in addressing the needs of the elderly.

The fourth technical session was titled '*Problems Associated with Elderly Citizens*' and was chaired by Dr. AlaknandaShringare, Associate Professor, ManoharParrikar School of Law, Governance and Public Policy. Dr. Amrita Sanyal Thakur, Professor, Ramnarayan College of Law, Dahisar-Mumbai said that isolation among the elderly is defined by the size of one's network and frequency of contacts. Loneliness among the elderly is a modern epidemic. She elaborated on the consequences of loneliness and the reasons for loneliness among the elderly.

Dr. PriyaOnske, Assistant Professor, VM Salgaocar College of Law enunciated the financial insecurity and interconnected problems faced by the elderly such as rising health care costs, lack of companionship, increase in daily living expenses and so on. Smt. RanjitaPai, Chairperson, Goa State Commission for Women, Govt. of Goa spoke on the maintenance and welfare of parents and Senior Citizens Act 2007. She elaborated on the welfare measures provided by the



State Government such as facility for treatment of chronic, terminal and degenerative diseases. establishment of old age homes, welfare schemes and so on.

Rakshanda Mayekar, Research Scholar, Department of Sociology, DDKSSBS put forward various case studies to elucidate the socio-economic status of elderly women residing in institutional care homes in Goa.

The Valedictory Function was held in the distinguished presence of Honourable Shri Justice Mahesh S. Sonak, Senior Judge, High Court of Bombay at Goa, who was the Chief Guest for the same, Senior Professor V.S. Nadkarni, Registrar, Goa University, Ms. Sherin Paul, Honourable Principal District and Sessions Judge, North Goa, Senior Professor Rajendra S. Gad, Dean MPSLGPP and Professor Ganesh Somayaji, Dean DDKSSBS.

The Seminar was attended by 218 participants which included faculty and students of Goa University as well as faculty and students from various colleges of Goa. The Seminar has been particularly beneficial to the future aspirants of those aspiring a career in law. 

About the Seminar

Rights for all, irrespective of age, are a fundamental tenet of humanity, with the process of aging being a natural phase within the human lifespan. India is experiencing a significant increase in its elderly population, currently holding the position of the second largest globally. The rapid pace of economic advancement, urban development, and consumerism surge has unfortunately cast a spotlight on the severe issue of elder abuse. The elderly is perceived as susceptible for a myriad of reasons including psychological, social, physical, and legal aspects. Daily, their rights are infringed upon, despite the existence of various laws, policies, and programs designed to meet their needs.

However, the efforts cannot end here; more proactive measures are essential. The societal perception of the elderly varies, and change is an expected constant. Nonetheless, it is crucial to recognise that neglect of the elderly and senior citizens is not an option. Their invaluable contributions to family and society, their rich life experiences, and their profound expertise and skills need appreciation and utilisation, with a keen focus on their preferences and comfort.

In response to this, the Manohar Parrikar School of Law, Governance and Public Policy, in collaboration with the D.D.
