The objective/description of the activity	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The Orientation Programme is aimed at providing appropriate direction to professional learning. The students got familiarized with the problems of society, especially marginalized and weaker sections.• They were made aware of the existing resource base available for their development and ways of

mobilizing them and motivating them to initiate work in the field.

- The two-day orientation programme involved visits to 6 different organizations addressing various need-based social problems in Goa
- St. Xavier's Academy is a school and hostel for children with disability. The students got an exposure to understand the pedagogy, activities, infrastructure and challenges faced by staff of the school.
- Caritas NGO runs various programmes in Goa like schools for disabled, environment related projects, day care centres, old age home etc. the students interacted with the head of the institution and asked various questions related to the services provided by Caritas
- A visit to Wanarmare Community at Virnoda, Pernem was an eye opener to the students who interacted with 70+ community members who shared about their socio-demographical profile, lifestyle, challenges faced. The students observed the conditions of their houses and basic amenities. The community members also shared that they feel alienated.
- Humsaath Trust staff gave detailed understanding about transgender community and HIV/AIDS to our students. There were several questions which were answered patiently by the staff members.
- The students were also taken to see WISH (Women Initiative for Self-Help) of ARZ NGO to witness rehabilitation unit for human trafficked victims. The staff explained about

	<p>journey of ARZ, their strategies to work to combat sexual violence and human trafficking and rehabilitation unit manufacturing tissue papers, paper bags, upcycling of old clothes into cloth bags, pouches, folders, etc.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Kiran Niketan, a community-based organisation works with Birla (Zuarinagar) Slums in Vasco. They run a primary school and social centre. Through social Centre they conduct tuition classes, tailoring classes, computer classes. They also conduct health camps and other need-based community programmes.
<p>Benefit/Key outcome of the event</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Through these visits, the social work students could learn about interventions for children with disabilities, persons with disability, senior citizen, victims of sexual violence and human trafficking, wanarmari community tribe, transgender community and slum dwellers.

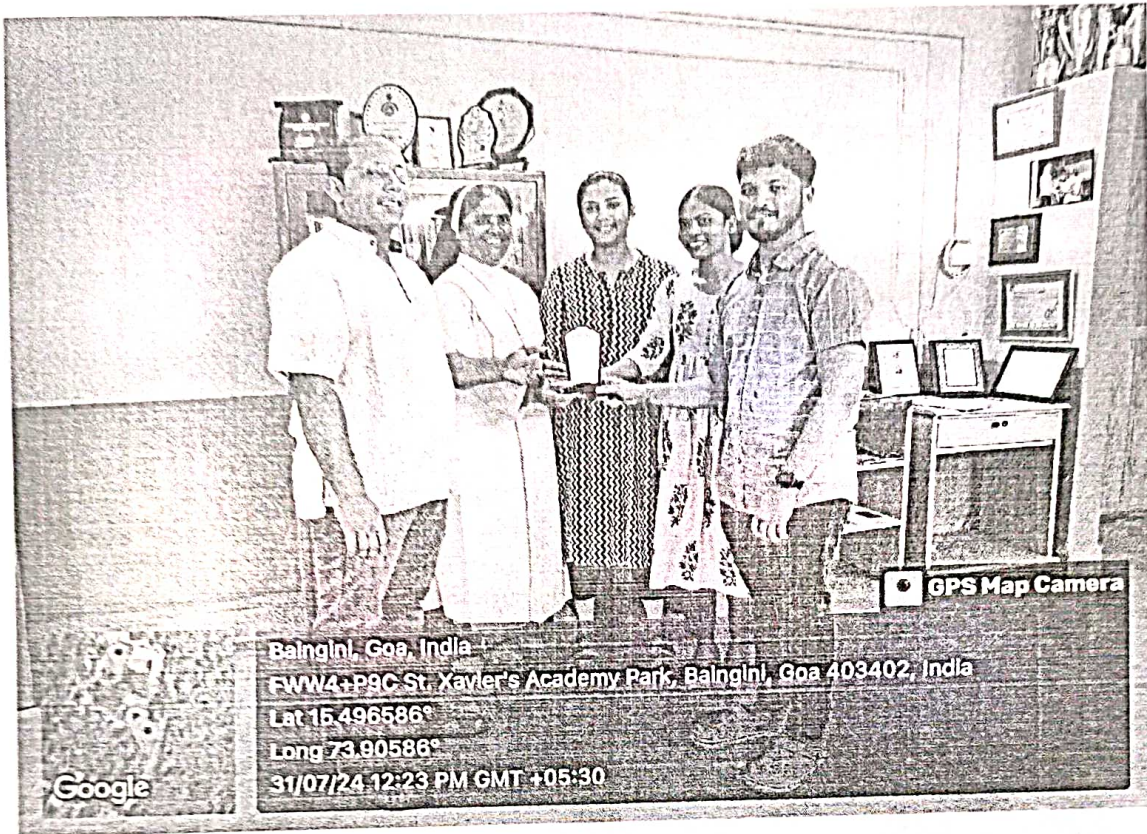

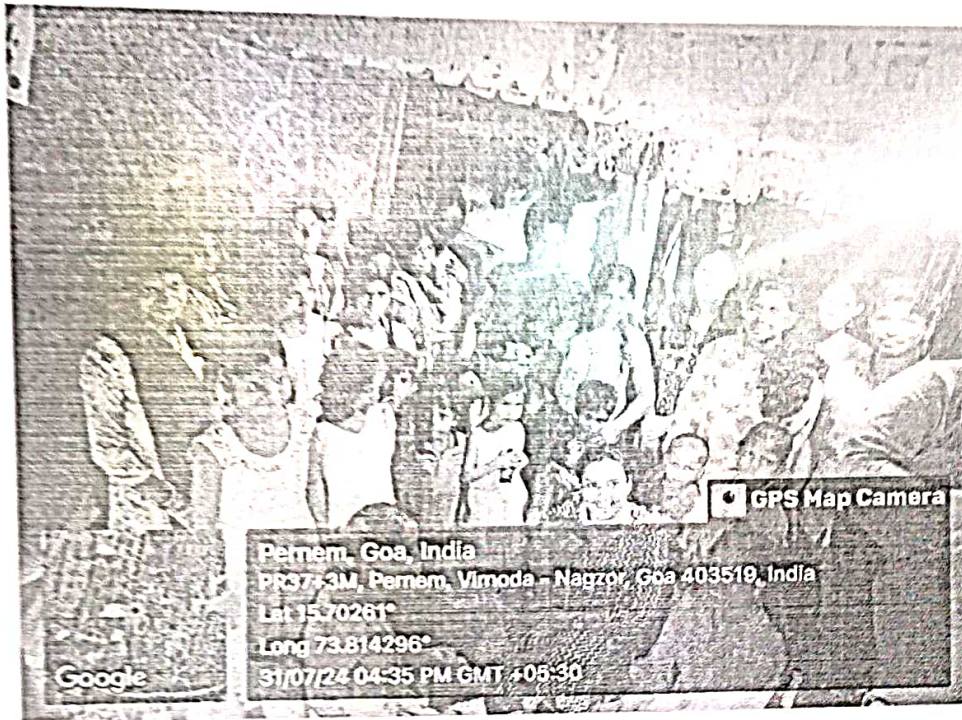
