This International Day of the World's Indigenous Peoples 2024 focuses on 'Protecting the Rights of Indigenous Peoples in Voluntary Isolation and Initial Contact'. The program began with a ceremonial lamp lighting by the Honorable Vice-Chancellor, Senior Professor Harilal B. Menon, accompanied by Professor Ganesha Somayaji, Dean of DDKSSSBS, Professor Rajendra Gad, Dean of MPS, Professor Bernard Rodrigues, Dean of SBSB, and Dr. Maria Norma Menezes, DEOC. Professor Ganesha Somayaji welcomed the gathering, and the Honorable Vice-Chancellor, Senior Professor Harilal B. Menon, delivered the presidential speech. Dr. Vijay Gawas, the event coordinator, expressed gratitude in the vote of thanks. The panel sessions commenced at 11:45 a.m. with Dr. Arvind Haldankar, Associate Professor of Sociology, moderating the session.
