11. Description of the Program/activity/event	<p>The Men's Hostel and Women's Hostel organized a comprehensive workshop on "Anti-Ragging" on 14th August 2024, aimed at educating and creating awareness among students about the detrimental effects of ragging. The event, held at 03:00 p.m. in the Seminar Hall (Block B), featured an array of distinguished speakers and engaging activities designed to promote a ragging-free campus environment.</p> <p>Dr. Priya D'costa, Assistant Professor and Chief Warden of Women's Hostels, Goa University, began the workshop by welcoming the invitees and students. She provided a brief overview of ragging as a significant social problem, setting the stage for the discussions that followed.</p> <p>Dr. Kanchanmala Deshpande, Assistant Professor Biochemistry and Nodal Officer of the Anti-Ragging Committee, Goa University, provided a detailed explanation of the concept of ragging, outlining what constitutes ragging, the legal consequences, and the UGC Anti-Ragging Guidelines. She emphasized the punishable offences associated with ragging and the measures implemented to address and prevent ragging on campus.</p> <p>Dr. Anthony Viegas, Director, Directorate of Student Welfare, Goa University highlighted the proactive steps taken by Goa University to combat ragging and create a safe campus environment. His insights into the university's initiatives underscored the institution's commitment to eradicating ragging.</p> <p>As a special guest, Asst. Prof. Naik, School of International & Area Studies, Goa University shared real-life experiences of public figures</p>

	<p>and their hostel lives. He provided valuable insights into the reasons behind the introduction of The Goa Prohibition of Ragging Act, 2008, and how it aims to tackle ragging.</p> <p>The workshop also featured a series of activities conducted by hostel inmates, including:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Anti-Ragging Poster Release: To visually promote awareness. 2. Skit Play: To dramatize the impacts of ragging and reinforce the anti-ragging message. 3. Documentary Film: Showcasing real-life stories and consequences of ragging. 4. Poem Reading: To convey the emotional and psychological effects of ragging. <p>Mr. Abhinay Pai, Warden of Men's Hostel, Goa University concluded the workshop by proposing the vote of thanks. He expressed gratitude to the speakers, participants, and organizers for their contributions and support.</p> <p>The workshop concluded with a collective pledge by the students to ensure a ragging-free campus. The pledge emphasized the commitment to maintaining discipline and contributing positively to the development and excellence of the country.</p> <p>The event was a significant step towards fostering a safer and more respectful campus environment, promoting awareness about the serious consequences of ragging, and encouraging students to uphold the values of integrity and respect.</p>

	could result in Ragging; Students were also aware of the available remedies at university as well as National level to curb ragging. The outcome of this workshop was the message given to students that the ragging is strictly frowned upon in institution and will be dealt with severe consequences, if anyone is found guilty of indulging in it.

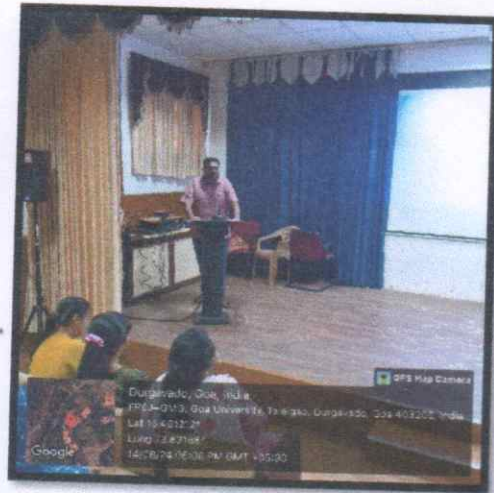
