6. Detail of the Resource Person (Brief biodata)	Adv. Runjun Dutta: A lawyer specializing in health access and human rights laws with over 15 years of experience. Adv. Dutta is currently affiliated with an international non-profit organization, where she passionately advocates for health equity and justice, particularly for marginalized communities in lower-middle-income countries. Her work is instrumental in driving policy reforms, leading legal challenges against the prohibitive costs

	of life-saving medicines, and pushing for patent law reforms that prioritize public health over corporate profit. In addition to her legal expertise, she is trained in Human Resource Management and is a CPD-certified trainer in Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI) and the Prevention of Sexual Harassment of Women at the Workplace (PoSH Act 2013).

To explore the intersection of healthcare, social justice, and advocacy, with a focus on the impact of pharmaceutical industry policies on public health. To equip participants with actionable strategies for advocacy in addressing systemic inequities in healthcare.
11. Description of the Event	The D.D. Kosambi School of Social Sciences and Behavioural Studies organized a guest lecture on 16th August 2024, focusing on "Advancing Health Equity and Justice: Challenges and Opportunities." The event featured Adv. Runjun Dutta, a renowned lawyer and expert in health access and human rights laws. The lecture began with an introduction by

Peter F. Borges, Coordinator of the Social Work Programme, who highlighted the importance of addressing health inequities and the role of social work in advocating for vulnerable populations.

Adv. Dutta delivered an engaging and insightful lecture, where she provided a comprehensive analysis of the barriers faced by marginalized communities in accessing healthcare. She discussed the significant influence of pharmaceutical industry policies, such as pricing and patent laws, which often hinder access to life-saving medicines. Adv. Following the lecture, an interactive Q&A session was held, allowing participants to engage directly with Adv. Dutta and delve deeper into the issues discussed. The Social Work Programme, DD Kosambi School of Social Sciences and Behavioural Studies at Goa University hosted a guest lecture, 'Advancing Health Equity and Justice: Challenges and Opportunities,' delivered by the Adv Runjun Dutta. The interactive session that followed allowed attendees to engage directly with Adv Dutta, asking questions and exploring the topics further, making the event both educational and deeply engaging. The session concluded with the presentation of a memento to Adv Dutta, in recognition of her valuable contribution to the discourse on health equity and justice.
