10. The objectives of the Program/activity/event	This course seeks to be a space to unveil musical practices and processes in Goa through ethnography. The practice of music and dance in Goa is and has been one of the most important features to identify the territory and to distinguish it as a singular place. Based on an interdisciplinary approach inherent to the framework of ethnomusicology, this course prioritizes ethnography as the main tool to describe and analyses music and dance in Goa.

Description of the Program/activity/event	The one-credit course for the post-graduate students, also open to the public consisted of lecture delivered by the Visiting Professor Susana Sardo from the University of Aveiro, Portugal. Additionally, there were presentations made by persons engaged in the process of documenting various musical practices in Goa, such as the Mando and the Tiatr.

Benefit/Key outcomes of the Program/activity/event	The students were introduced to the field of ethnomusicology and the importance of documenting the various musical components of the course offered the participants a basic understanding which will help in their future work in the field of ethnomusicology.

Bio Data

Professor Susana Sardo is a prominent ethnomusicologist and Full Professor at the University of Aveiro, Portugal. She also holds a position as a Visiting Professor at the University of Goa, India, for the J.H. Cunha Rivara Chair. She is known for her extensive research on music in Goa and its diasporic communities, particularly within the context of Lusophony, which explores the cultural and linguistic legacy of Portuguese colonialism.

Sardo has been actively involved in numerous research projects and initiatives. In 2007, she founded the Aveiro branch of the Research Centre for Ethnomusicology (INET-md) and coordinated it until January 2023. She has also served as a member of various committees and organizations, including the International Council for Traditional Music, where she was elected to the Executive Board (ORCID) (Ciência Vitae).

Her research interests are diverse, covering topics such as music and post-colonialism, sound archives, music in the Lusophone world, and the intersection of music and post-dictatorship regimes. Sardo's work has been instrumental in advancing the field of ethnomusicology, particularly through her efforts to document and analyze the musical traditions of Portuguese-speaking countries (University of Aveiro).
