Description of the Program/activity/event</p>	<p>On 18 October 2024 , on the way the team visited Aamche Daaiz Museum at Keri, Sattari, Goa which has showcased the Folklife and traditional materials. Students got an insight into things and materials used by local people in their day to day life. The team proceeded to Bandirwada, Karanzol located in Sattari taluka. The team experienced the difficulties faced by the community in terms of no accessibility to health, education and how people staying in this village live with limited resources. The team was briefed about the community by Ms. Sandhya Gaonkar. The village has total 15 houses belonging to Dhangar community. Team interacted with men and women to understand their day to day living. Team visited two Government Primary schools on 19 October 2024 located in two different wards one having 5 students and other having 12 students and conducted activities for the students and presented prizes for taking part in the activities. In both the schools we noticed single teachers were handling the teaching learning activities in the Government Primary Schools. Besides, team also visited anganwadi centre. There were total 10 students enrolled at anganwadi centre. Team also played games with these kids. In one school parents were also participated during the visit. One of the community members Team also visited temple sight where annually during HOLI Festival , Chor religious ritual is conducted. . Team thanked the community for hosting the students and facilitating the logistic arrangements. Students to present their experiences and learnings as a presentation and submit report on 24 October 2024.</p>
