Netravali is a village located in Sanguem Taluka, South Goa, known for its biodiversity and traditional Goan lifestyle. It lies within the Western Ghats, a UNESCO World Heritage site, making the area an important ecological zone. Netravali is famous for its lush greenery, dense forests, and waterfalls. The village is part of the Netravali Wildlife Sanctuary, home to a wide range of flora and fauna, including several endangered species.  The faculty and students visited Netravali Village on 18 October 2024. The visit included an itinerary with the specific places: Netravali Wildlife Sanctuary, Tanshikar Spice Farm, Budbudo Lake, Ghufa Datta Temple, Usgalimal Rock Engravings, and Bhuddist Caves in Rivona.  The night stay was at Nirmal Nature Campsite, Quepem.
9. Benefit/Key outcomes of the Program/activity/event	Through direct observation and interaction, students developed critical thinking and analytical skills.  The visit provided primary data for student assignments and projects.  This experiential learning also complemented classroom teachings and enhanced students' insights into the eco-tourism and its impact on society and the environment.
