Event/Activity/Program	The major objective of this talk was to understand are research, teaching, and mentoring complement each other and are essential for achieving excellence in students and, consequently, in
	the institution. Prof. Rajiv Sangal highlighted that there are three major responsibilities of a faculty member: Conduct research, do teaching, and mentor students. All the three are necessary to inspire students and get them to go for deeper learning. It also leads to an impactful life of a faculty member. Teaching is the first step in inspiring students and encouraging them to explore and gain a thorough understanding. Allowing students to explore through research, makes them see the limits of knowledge and strive to go beyond. Finally, mentoring is an important part of student guidance, and is not limited only to a subject or a branch, but concerns life itself. Prof. Sangal emphasized that these three are complementary and are required to reach excellence - in the students, and consequently in
	the institution.
11. Description of the Event/Activity/Program	The program was initiated by Prof. Jyoti D. Pawar, by giving a background and the objective behind organizing the talk. This was followed by an introduction of the speaker by Ms. Pradnya Bhagat. With the help of his decades of experience, case studies, and real-life examples, Prof. Rajeev Sangal demonstrated the importance of dedication, teamwork and interdisciplinary collaboration in achieving excellence in research, academics, and
	life. He provided examples of initiatives such as the introduction of Machine Translation research and Natural Language Processing (NLP) in India, as well as the incubation and success of the Bhashini project, which resulted from excellence in research and collaboration. Prof. Sangal also highlighted the significance of using innovative methods to engage students in their studies, such as creative
	induction programs, and emphasized the crucial role of proper mentorship in establishing universal human values. At the conclusion of the talk, The Vice-Dean (Research), Senior Professor Pranab Mukhopadhyay, shared the insights the audience gained from the talk. MSc (AI) Program Coordinator Shri. S. Baskar handed over a memento to the speaker, Prof. Rajeev Sangal.
