	 challenges, and therapeutic interventions. Centre for Youth Development & Activities (CYDA): Exposure to youth empowerment programs, including

support for LGBTQIA+ and vulnerable communities. Jerwada Slum & Police Station: Insights into urban poverty, enforcement, and collaboration between social workers and authorities. Saheli Sangh & Budhwar Peth Red Light Area: Understanding issues faced by marginalized communities like sex workers, including human trafficking and HIV/AIDS. Family Planning Association: Insights into reproductive health and family planning services. Deepgriha **Society:** Exposure grassroots initiatives improving marginalized communities through education, healthcare, and child welfare. Tribal Cultural Museum: Understanding the culture and history of indigenous communities. **Parivartan**: Exposure to mental health interventions community-based and counseling. 12. Benefit/Key Outcomes of the Students gained practical understanding of social organizations in **Event** Pune, learning skills in planning, organizing, and evaluating study tours. Key learnings included conscious time management, communication skills, team spirit, conflict resolution, resource sharing, and problem-solving.
