10. The objectives of the Program/activity/event	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Understanding the nature and construction of knowledge and whether it could be objective and value-neutral? 2. How does gender play a significant role in the process of knowledge? 3. Whether the concerns of feminist epistemologists change the way we perceive our world and the way we make sense of our experiences? 4. What is epistemic injustice, epistemic ignorance, epistemic privilege and epistemic responsibility?
11. Description of the Program/activity/event	Dr. Reetu Jaiswal's lectures explored how gender influences knowledge creation and understanding. She examined how the perception of knowledge as objective and unbiased is challenged by feminist epistemologists, who argue that both scientific and cultural knowledge often marginalize women's experiences. Dr. Jaiswal discussed how women experience epistemic injustice and are both disadvantaged and, paradoxically, epistemically privileged due to their unique perspectives. The lecture also

	addressed the responsibilities of dominant groups in perpetuating epistemic ignorance and prompted reflection on how these issues impact everyday interactions and the construction of knowledge.
