Mr. Nautiyal highlighted on the type of work and workload to be taken up as a fellow of Teach for India movement and briefed the candidates about their salary structure. He made the students understand their duties if appointed as the Teach for India fellow. He explained the entire selection procedure for the candidates in order to be selected as the Teach for India fellows. The selection process was basically divided in 3 parts: first: the application and online test, second: phone interviews and third: final interviews. He requested the candidates to apply for the programme and many candidates applied for the same.
