Description of the Program/activity/event	<p>On 30th August 2024, the inaugural lecture of lecture series under the Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Chair in Leadership and Governance was organized by Manohar Parrikar School of Law, Governance and Public Policy in collaboration with D.D Kosambi School of Social Sciences and behavioural studies at 10 am in the Conference Hall of the Goa University. The theme of the inaugural lecture was "International Leadership and Governance: Ensuring Responsible Conduct in Peacekeeping Missions".</p>



	<p>The commencement of the session was marked by lighting of the traditional lamp by all the dignitaries.</p> <p>Prof. Rajendra S. Gad (Dean, MPSLGPP) in his welcome address brought notice to two important characteristics of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj i.e. administrative skill and bravery.</p> <p>Prof. Koshy Tharakan (Dean of Sanskrit, Philosophy and Indic Studies) ,the Presiding Authority of the lecture spoke about two kinds of philosophers, ones who actively respond to situations and the others who are silent contemplators.</p> <p>The lecture commenced with the Keynote speaker speaking about the UN's incorporation of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj's beliefs and ideals. He spoke about the need of Peacekeeping operations, the conditions of women during armed conflicts, and the nature of sexual crimes in peace operations. He also showcased the challenges in adopting policies or setting up a legal inquiry in these cases as legislation, methods of evidence collection and other relevant parameters differ from country to country.</p> <p>The keynote speaker also brought forth the best practices and encouraging examples which include recruitment of women in armed forces and blood sample collection of peacekeepers in order to prove the offence by matching DNA with that of the baby. He also highlighted the role of FFPU's (Fully Female Police Units) contributed by India which includes providing security, teaching self defence, educating about dangers of HIV /AIDS and encouraging women to join law enforcement. The lecture concluded with Q & A session.</p>

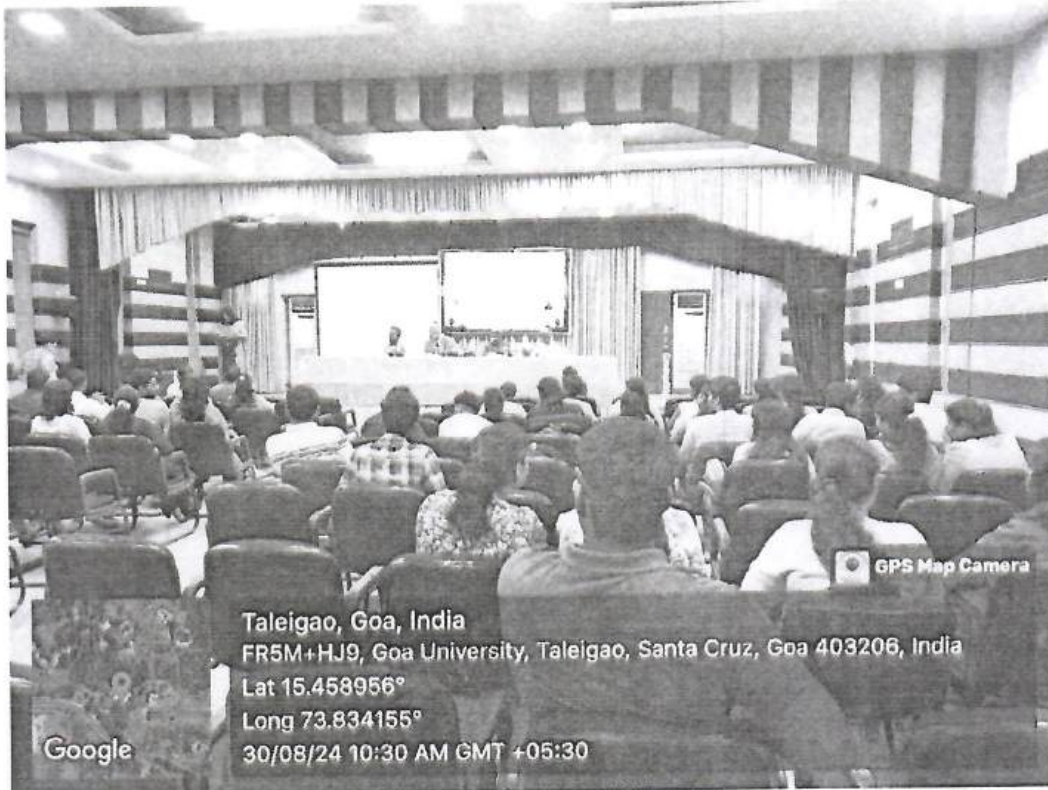
