10. Objectives of the Event	 To assist the Kathkari Tribal Community in securing delayed birth and marriage registrations. To provide healthcare services and improve community living conditions. To offer students practical, field-based learning aligned with the principles of social inclusion and empowerment.
11. Description of the Event	 The Community Engagement Day with the Kathkari Tribal Community, a Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Group (PVTG), was organized to address systemic barriers and promote inclusion. Key activities included: Delayed Birth and Marriage Registration Camp: Facilitated by social work students, faculty, and volunteers from the Pernem Free Legal Aid Cell, this camp supported the Kathkari community in accessing legal identity and unlocking rights to essential services like education and healthcare.
	• Health Camp: Supported by IMA

	 Bardez and Department of Radiology and Oral Medicine, Goa Dental College, the camp provided general health check-ups, dental screenings, and consultations, ensuring access to vital healthcare. Hut Renovation Activity: A hands-on project where students, faculty, and community members worked together to improve living conditions, fostering resilience and sustainability. The initiative was supported by Turbocam International Pvt. Ltd., Harley Owners Group Goa Chapter, Sanitation and Hygiene Committee, and Unnat Bharat Abhiyan, alongside individual donors.
12. Benefit/Key Outcomes of the Event	• Empowerment Through Documentation: Community members gained access to critical legal identity documents.
	• Improved Health Access: The health camp provided essential services to an underserved community.
	• Enhanced Student Learning: Students gained practical exposure to social work in action, reinforcing their theoretical knowledge with real-world application.
	• Community Collaboration: The event fostered trust and partnership between Goa University, the Kathkari community, and supporting agencies.
