<b>11. Description of the Program/activity/event</b>	<p>The Women's Studies Programme of the DD Kosambi School of Social Sciences and Behavioural Studies, Goa University had organized MEAR (Making Equality a Reality) 2025 on 7th March 2025 at the Seminar Hall, Faculty Block B, Goa University from 9:00 AM to 5:30 PM. The event, themed "Accelerate Action," aims to promote equality and inspire proactive efforts toward social change.</p> <p>MEAR 2025 featured four significant competitions designed to engage participants creatively and intellectually. "MEAR Street Performer," invited participants to write, direct, and perform a street play based on the theme "<i>Accelerate Actions</i>." The plays were performed in Konkani, Hindi, Marathi, and English. The judging criteria included content and relevance to the theme, audibility and clarity, originality, and creativity, with each category scoring 20 points.</p> <p>"The MEAR Artist," challenges participants to express the theme through art. A canvas cloth was provided.. Copying from any source was strictly prohibited, and the decision of the judges were</p>

	<p>final. Judging criteria included originality creativity and relevance of the theme and overall message, "The Mear Reeler," invited participants to create a short reel addressing the theme. All submitted reels were screened during the event's inaugural session. Elocution competition was held around the theme and we received an overwhelming response from the participants. Dr Nistha Dessai, Priti Parab Saylee Loyekar and Sushamita Desai served as a Judges for this event. Total eight colleges from across Goa Participated in this event.</p>
<p><b>12. Benefit/Key outcomes of the Program/activity/event</b></p>	<p>MEAR 2025 successfully created a platform for raising awareness about social inequalities and inspiring action toward equality. MEAR 2025 strengthened community engagement by bringing together individuals from diverse backgrounds and encouraging dialogue on social change. The event successfully inspired participants and the audience to reflect on societal challenges and motivated them to take proactive steps toward building a more equitable and just society.</p>

### 4. MEAR ORATOR

- **Theme:** Accelerate Action–Bridging Gender Gaps in Contemporary India
- **Rules:**
  - ❖ Maximum two individual participants per institution.
  - ❖ If both participants win individual prizes, only the higher scorer's points will contribute to the team's overall score, though both will receive individual prizes.
  - ❖ Speech duration: 5-7 minutes.
  - ❖ Language: English, Konkani, Marathi and Hindi.
  - ❖ Topics must reflect researched insights and align with the theme, focusing on contemporary gender issues in India (e.g., digital gender divide, gendered impacts of climate change, legal reforms).
  - ❖ Plagiarism or offensive language will result in disqualification.
- **Judging Criteria (20 points each):**
  - ❖ Content and research depth.
  - ❖ Clarity and argumentation.
  - ❖ Creativity and originality.
  - ❖ Delivery and engagement.
  - ❖ Overall relevance to the theme.

### 1. MEAR STREET PERFORMERS

- **Theme:** Accelerate Action: Breaking Barriers: Dismantling Gender Stereotypes in Indian Society
- **Rules:**
  - ❖ Maximum 10 participants per team.
  - ❖ Duration: 5-7 minutes.
  - ❖ Language: Konkani, Hindi, Marathi, or English.
  - ❖ Props are allowed but must be minimal and easy to set up.
  - ❖ Any offensive or disrespectful content will lead to disqualification.
- **Judging Criteria (20 points each):**
  - ❖ Content and relevance to the theme.
  - ❖ Audibility and clarity in the message.
  - ❖ Originality of the concept and script.
  - ❖ Creativity in execution.

### 2. MEAR ARTIST

- **Theme:** Accelerate Action: Visualizing Equality: Depicting Gender Balance in Everyday Life
- **Rules:**
  - ❖ A maximum of two participants per team.
  - ❖ Duration: 1 hour 30 minutes.
  - ❖ Each team will be provided with a designated space for painting.
  - ❖ Canvas board will be provided; participants must bring Acrylic paint and brushes.
  - ❖ Copying from any source is strictly prohibited.
  - ❖ Judges' decision will be final.
- **Judging Criteria (50 points each):**
  - ❖ Originality and creativity.

### 5. PRIZES & RECOGNITION

- Individual prizes for all competitions will be awarded.
- **Team Total:** Points from the top participant in each category (if applicable) will contribute to the team's final score for an overall winner.
- Certificates will be awarded to all participants, with trophies for winners for each competition and overall winners and runner's up.
